

Dear Parents,

Orange Grove Charter is proud to announce our 3rd Musical Theater Summer Camp located at the middle school campus! At this camp, students will work on a Broadway Junior production! This opportunity is only open to students who are rising 6th-9th graders for the 2019-2020 school year.

Broadway Junior productions are musicals that have been performed on Broadway or with one of Broadway's touring troupes. A Broadway Junior production is usually about 45 minutes long, instead of the three hour long full length Broadway production. Think of it like the cliff notes version. ☺

Camp will be the week of July 10-19, 2019. Our performance will be on Friday, July 19th at 4:30pm. Summer camp hours will be 9:00am-3:00pm and at a cost of \$250 per student. Auditions are NOT required to being in MTSC. However, this opportunity is only available to those students who have a passion for musical theater, performing, and stage crew.

Students will need to fill out the following application and have it turned in to Ms. Miller at the middle school or to Mrs. Flint at the elementary school by April 5, 2019. Late applications will not be accepted. **Students will be selected based on a lottery.** If you want in, get your application in ASAP! Please only fill out this application if you will be at every rehearsal. Attendance is extremely important. We are putting on a full Broadway Junior production in just one week! **If a student misses too many camp days, they may not be able to perform in the musical performance and will NOT receive a camp refund.**

Students who are selected for Musical Theater Summer Camp will be notified by April 9, 2019. Once you receive a congratulations letter, your camp fees may be placed through RevTrak and will need to be paid by the end of this school year. We will be holding auditions in May so that you can begin working on your part over the summer. Audition dates will be given on your acceptance letter.

Our choice of show is determined by how many students have been selected through the lottery. The more students who apply, the better the chances for us to select a great musical to perform.

We are so excited to welcome Mrs. Webster to help direct our MTSC this year alongside Ms. Miller. She has been an integral part of our set design for our past productions and will continue to share her artistic talents in rehearsals!
